I understand that my duties also include:

- Doorbelling with campaign material for endorsed candidates prior to each primary and general election
- Get-out-the-vote activities
- New voter registration

In order to keep informed of Party projects and issues, I agree to regularly attend meetings of my Democratic Legislative District organization. In order to fulfill my responsibilities to elect Democratic Party officers and to help form Democratic Party platforms and policy positions, I also agree to participate in precinct, Legislative District and King County caucuses and conventions, as well as meetings of the King County Democratic Central Committee. I am legally registered to vote at the address specified below and understand that, if appointed as a PCO, service as PCO will be contingent on *remaining* registered to vote somewhere in my precinct (RCW 29A.80.041). Therefore, upon any move or other change of legal domicile that entails a change of registration to a new precinct, I agree to inform my district chair at the earliest opportunity.

I am not eligible to register to vote and therefore can only serve as an [Acting] PC.

If appointed as an [Acting] PC, I understand that my primary task as an will be to find a willing Democratic resident voter who can become the PCO for my service precinct.
